Day Five // Friday

On this day, Jesus was arrested, tried, and sentenced to death by crucifixion. He was mocked, beaten, and spat upon by the soldiers and the crowd. He carried His cross to Golgotha, where He was nailed to the wood and left to die. As He hung on the cross, He cried out, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Jesus willingly went to the cross, knowing that it was the only way to save us from our sins. He wasn't dragged to the cross; He chose it. He wasn't forced to give his life; He gave it willingly. Let us remember the immense sacrifice that Jesus made for us on this day, and the depth of his love for us.

"And when they came to a place called Golgotha (which means Place of a Skull), they offered him wine to drink, mixed with gall, but when he tasted it, he would not drink it. And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots. Then they sat down and kept watch over him there. And over his head they put the charge against him, which read, 'This is Jesus, the King of the Jews.'"
